



Math in Nature Educator Workshop



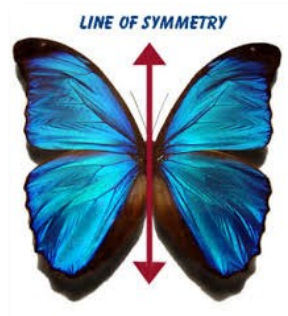
